- Must be able to read drawings and/or prints
- Experience using saws of all types
- Experience using industrial staple gun and industrial nail gun
- Must be able to read a tape measure
- Experience building pallets and crates
- Must have knowledge of material being used (2X4, 2X6 etc)
- Ability to lift approximately 50 to 100 pounds
- Needs to be able to stand for long periods of time and bend frequently
- Must be punctual
- Must be able to work overtime

Working in the woodshop is a fast pace environment. The woodshop builds 17 to 20 skids per hour and are often given orders just hours before they are needed. You would work closely with customer service and all other departments. Along with building skids they build crates. The woodshop crates product to ship locally and overseas along with customer onsite crating of machines. Making product to print is crucial, especially when shipping overseas. Attention to detail and following woodshop procedures is a must. Operating several types of saws, industrial glue gun, industrial staple gun, and an industrial nail gun just to name a few, requires someone who has the ability to safely work at a fast pass with the understanding of the equipment they are operating.
